

RULES OF PARTICIPATION **IN THE 3 DAYS OF AIGLE 2023 EVENTS**

Participation in the 3 days of Aigle Men Elite is reserved for teams made up of:

- 1 Men U23 rider associated with 1 Men Elite rider
- 2 Men U23 riders

A maximum of 15 teams will be selected from the entries. If more than 15 teams register, the selection will be made on 31 August 2023:

- The deadline for entries is Monday 24 August 2023
- A maximum of 2 teams per foreign nation will be allowed to start
- The number of Swiss teams will be a maximum of 6
- The organizer reserves the right not to accept an entry from a team that does not sufficiently master the American technique
- The gear ratio for Madison races is limited to 57x15

Teams register on the <https://www.3joursdaigle.ch> website, under registrations, by filling in the form and returning it to 3joursdaigle@gmail.com. When registering, riders must list their 2 best Madison results in their prize list. This is to prove that they have mastered the technique of this discipline.

The selected riders will receive a daily allowance of CHF 100.00, which corresponds to a total of CHF 600.00 per team, which will have to cover their accommodation and meals.

The registration fee is € 30 / CHF 30 per rider. The registration fee only must be paid once, even if the rider takes part in several UCI events during the 3 days. This amount will be deducted directly from the riders' prices.

Meal vouchers can be ordered when registering for lunch in the WCC restaurant (CHF 15) and for dinner on the lawn (CHF 8).

Participation in the Mini 3 Jours d'Aigle is reserved for teams made up of:

- 2 Men U19 riders
- 1 Men's U19 rider and 1 Elite Women's rider

A U23 rider associated with a U19 rider or 2 U23 riders or a U23 rider associated with a Female Elite rider may be authorized to take part in the Mini 3 Jours if their level is deemed insufficient to take part in the Elite races.

A maximum of 15 teams will be selected from the entries. If more than 15 teams register, the selection will be made on 31 August 2023:

- The organizer reserves the right not to consider the entry of a team that does not sufficiently master the American technique.
- The gear ratio for all races is limited to 51x15

Foreign teams can register on the website <https://www.3joursdaigle.ch>, under registrations, by filling in the form and sending it to 3joursdaigle@gmail.com. When registering, riders must list their 2 best Madison results in their prize list. This is to prove that they have mastered the technique of this discipline.

The 30 riders selected will be provided with accommodation and meals from the evening of Thursday 28 September 2023 until the evening of Saturday 30 October 2023. The entry fee is CHF 70 or € 70.

For riders staying at home or booking their own accommodation, the entry fee will be CHF 30.- or € 30.- and will include evening meals.

On request, we can organize accommodation and meals for one accompanying person per Mini 3 Days team for € 55.- / CHF 55.- per day. If the delegation includes more than one accompanying person, the latter will be responsible for all accommodation and meal costs.

Participation in the Piccolo 3 Jours d'Aigle is reserved for teams composed of:

- 2 men U17
- 2 Women U17
- 1 U17 men's rider and 1 U17 women's rider

A U19 rider combined with a U17 rider or 2 U19 riders may be authorized to compete in the Mini 3 Jours if their level is deemed insufficient to take part in the Mini races.

A maximum of 15 teams will be selected from the entries. If more than 15 teams register, the selection will be made on 31 August 2023:

- The organizer reserves the right not to accept the entry of a team that does not sufficiently master the American technique
- The gear ratio for Madison races is limited to 49x15
- If enough participants register to have a Piccolo Men's category and a Piccolo Women's category, two categories will be created. Otherwise, men and women will take part in the same events

Foreign teams can register on the website, under registrations, by filling in the form and returning it to 3joursdaigle@gmail.com. When registering, riders must list their 2 best Madison results in their prize list. This is to prove that they have mastered the technique of this discipline.

The 30 riders selected will be provided with accommodation and meals from the evening of Thursday 28 September 2023 until the evening of Saturday 30 October 2023. The entry fee is CHF 70 or € 70.

For riders staying at home or booking their own accommodation, the entry fee will be CHF 30.- or € 30.- and will include evening meals.

On request we can organize accommodation and meals for one accompanying person per Piccolo 3 Days team for € 55.- / CHF 55.- per day. If the delegation includes more than one accompanying person, the latter will be responsible for all accommodation and meal costs.

U19 homme :

- Scratch

Entries will close on 24 August and the final selection will be made on 31 August 2023.

Depending on the number of riders entered, a maximum of 2, 3 or 4 riders per foreign nation will be authorized to start individual UCI races. This is to enable as many nations as possible

to take part.

All participants in the UCI races, except for riders in the Mini and Piccolo 3 jours d'Aigle categories, must organize their own accommodation and meals.

Meal vouchers can be booked on the registration form for lunch in the WCC restaurant (CHF 15) and dinner on the lawn (CHF 8).

The registration fee is € 30 / CHF 30 per rider. The registration fee is payable only once, even if the rider takes part in several UCI events over the 3 days.

If the delegation includes a companion, the latter will cover all accommodation and meal costs.
